

Case # 3 - Fred

Fred presented on March 15th, 2020 with a wound of unknown origin on his left rear fetlock. On presentation the wound was a combination of cellulitis and edema. A catscan was performed to determine the extent of the injury. Fred was placed on oral and iv antibiotics. Treatment with VetBlue dressings began on March 20th.



Wound prior to starting VetBlue PVA - 3/15

First Application of Hydrofera Blue Classic –3/20

VetBlue PVA secured with rolled gauze and vetwrap.



Dressing Change 4/2

The VetBlue dressing removed the slough and devitalized tissue leaving a healthy wound bed - an ideal environment for healing.



Dressing Change – 4/6

Wound showing significant progress just 2 1/2 weeks after beginning VetBlue treatment.

Wound closure – 8/30

In just over one month of treatment with Hydrofera Blue Classic, the wound was brought to closure.
